## **Background:**

After the devastating earthquake of magnitude 7.9 on April 25<sup>th</sup>, the whole nation shook. Nepalese living abroad were in grief and worried how to help instantly. Hundreds of Nepali in Helsinki region gathered and expressed condolences to victims of earthquake. Meanwhile, a group was formed to go Nepal and deploy on rescue mission. After few days of homework, the team was able to fly Nepal on May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## Working area:

- We initially targeted 2 most affected districts Gorkha and Sindhupalchok. But with all added energy and spirit of volunteerism in group members, we succeeded to work on two more districts, Lalitpur and Nuwakot. All of our working areas were most remote areas of that district, devastated and lacking proper aid. Selection of volunteering areas was determined with the help of journalists, local administrative officers, news on social media, volunteering organization, etc.
- Gorkha: Saurpani and Dhodeni VDCs were covered. (just 2 KM away from the epicentre Barpak)
- Nuwakot: Fikuri VDC
- Sindhupalchok: Thulo Sirubari VDC
- Lalitpur: Gimdi VDC

# What we did?

- Medical camps set up. Conduct health check up and provide primary medical services. (Around 1000 people were served)
- Medicine distribution.
- Food packages distribution (rice, grain, etc)
- Tent distribution (around 300 houses)
- Mobile charging facilities for villagers (with a portable petrol generator) in Gorkha.
- Trauma-relief campaign and practical training for teachers (*Gorkha*: 80 teachers from 10 schools, *Makwanpur*: 100 teachers from 20 schools).
- Financial support on building old care home in Bhaktapur.
- Financial support on building a primary school.( Shree Janajyoti Prathamik Bidhyalaya, Chhoprak)
